The deadline for submission is midnight March 1, 2022

STEP 1:

Decide whether you are eligible to apply. You need to apply through one of Bowen Island's registered charities. You can search for the registered Bowen charities [HERE](#). Type 'Bowen Island' in the search box.

STEP 2:

Tell us about your “good idea” and WHY you believe it would directly benefit the Bowen Island community. 500 words MAXIMUM.

- Who would be involved (e.g. specific individuals, volunteers);
- Would the grant leverage other funding contributions;
- What is the expected timing for implementation of your project; and
- What impact do you expect or hope your project would have.

STEP 3:

Make sure to include:

- Your 500-word project synopsis.
- Page 2 of the application form completed.
- Print “KKN Small Grants Application” in the subject line.
